

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
September 22, 1992

The Board of Supervisors of Cerro Gordo County met in regular session pursuant to adjournment. Present: Ermer, Urdahl and Nannenga.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to approve the minutes of September 15, 1992 and today's agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

Nannenga motioned, with Urdahl seconding, to approve a Work Order for Drainage District 31. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to adopt Resolution 92-133, placing a speed limit sign on Mallard Avenue. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to adopt Resolution 92-134, payroll changes. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to adopt Resolution 92-135, purchase of \$300,000 in capital loan notes. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to direct the Board of Health to act as the County's representative in applying for the revolving loan and grant. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to adopt Resolution 92-136, tax abatement. Motion passed unanimously.

Urdahl motioned, with Nannenga seconding, to authorize the Chair to sign the EMS Training Grant application. Motion passed unanimously.
