Watts moved with Latham seconding, to approve dock permits for 61P. Motion passed unanimously.

Watts moved with Latham seconding, to approve reports from the Zoning Director and the Environmental Health Service Manager concerning Manure Management Plans filed by SunRay Pork Site 6 and forward them to the DNR with a notation that there is an increase of 154.97 acres. Motion passed unanimously.
