Latham moved with Watts seconding, to authorize Vice Chair to sign 13 month renewal for Cisco maintenance with IP Pathways. Motion passed.

Latham moved with Walts seconding, to approve reports from the Zoning Director and the Environmental Health Service Manager concerning Manure Management Plans filed by Caffrey Farms #58177, Research Farms (East Site) #66026, and Engels North #61341 and forward them to the DNR with the notation of 78.9 acre increase on Caffrey Farms and a 515.4 acre increase on Engels North.
