Latham moved with Watts seconding, to approve Resolution 2021-57, WHEREAS, the lowa Department of Transportation has adopted Administrative Rule 761, Chapter 164, which created the Traffic Safety Improvement Program (TSIP) to allow for funding to be provided to local jurisdictions for eligible traffic safety improvement projects; and WHEREAS, Cerro Gordo had determined that providing temporary traffic signals for use during maintenance activities will aid in improving safety for flaggers, maintenance workers, and the traveling public in road work zones; and WHEREAS, portable temporary traffic signals are recognized temporary traffic control devices in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition; and WHEREAS, the Cerro Gordo County Engineer recommends a TSIP application be submitted to the Iowa Department of Transportation for possible safety funding of the above-mentioned traffic control devices. IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors to endorse the abovementioned project and hereby commits to accepting and maintaining these temporary traffic signals; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson of the Cerro Gordo County Board of Supervisors authorize and direct the County Engineer to submit the said funding application to the Iowa Department of Transportation for possible Traffic Safety Improvement Funding.
