

Currently it is bare ground and has not been kept up. The ground as sat empty and not farmed
for over 6 years.

of Oaks, Walnuts and Cherry trees lines the outside of the property.


3. Explain how the variance will fit in with the character of the area (i.e., size, height, scale, etc.):
